

Please note as per APHA rules exhibits can only be accepted from registered premises and from a Bird flu free area. Please ensure that your APHA Customer ID and County Parish Holding number are entered on your entry form. Without this information your entries will be refused.

Rules & Regulations

- 1. This Show is held under the Rules of the all Border Specialist Clubs, agreed at the Border Convention in Birmingham.
- 2. Entries close for catalogue on Wednesday 5th November 2025. Any entry not in the Catalogue will not be eligible for B.B.F.C.C. Trophies or Specials as per Rule.
- 3. Exhibits must be staged by 9.00a.m. on Saturday 15th November 2025 when judging will commence. Stewards will be in attendance from 2 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. on Friday to receive exhibits
- 4. All exhibits entrusted to the care of the Committee will be properly looked after and special care will be taken to the packing of the birds for the return journey but the Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may happen to them on their way to or from the Show. Entries only accepted on these terms.
- 5. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entries without explanation
- 6. Exhibitors may state a price at which their exhibits may be sold but if so desired, may be marked N.F.S. on their entry form. The first claimant shall pay the entry price (cage not included).

Further claims may be made for the same bird and it will then go up for auction. All money over the catalogue price will be equally divided. The Committee shall deduct 10% of the selling price AND NO EXHIBIT SHALL BE DISPOSED OF PRIVATELY

- 7. No bird sold will be allowed to go out of the hall before 1.00p.m. on the last day of the Show except in the Sales Classes.
- 8. Sales Section. The Society undertakes to sell at such price as stated on the Entry Form and will deduct 10% Commission. Entries free. All sales through the Sales Steward,
- 9. *Lifting time for all exhibits will be 1.00 p.m. on Sunday.* This Rule will be strictly adhered to. Long-distance birds will be dealt with first.
- 10. Any protests must be accompanied by a fee of £5 and made in writing and lodged with the Secretary before 1.00 p.m. on the Sunday. Such protests will be considered by the Committee and if not upheld the deposit will be forfeited.
- 11. In the event of Judges not having time to judge their allocated classes, the show managers have the authorisation to re-allocate classes.
- 12. Only First Class Prize winners to go forward for Specials.
- 13. Only half the cash specials will be paid if there are less than five exhibitors in each section. Except donated specials which will be paid in full.
- 14. This show is held under a GENERAL LICENCE from D.E.F.R.A.

All unflighted birds in classes 17-46, 63-92, must be marked U/F on the entry form for them to compete for the Unflighted Specials.


Cinnamon Variegated bird must be entered in the Cinnamon Variegated classes or they will be wrong classed.


The Committee of the BBFCC would like to ask all exhibitors and visitors to refrain from selling birds or equipment from the car park.

BIO-SECURITY GUIDE LINES

- 1. A health statement should be included on all entry forms and a signed by the exhibitor, confirming that their stud is free of disease at the time of entry and benching.
- 2. Exhibitors and visitors to the show are asked to wear clean clothing not previously worn in the bird room.
- 3. Exhibitors must ensure all their exhibits are in clean cages. Failure to comply will result in the cage being rejected.
- 4. All stewards, judges and show personnel should apply a suitable viral hand steriliser to their hands before starting to handle cages..
- 5. As birds are being checked in, the bottom of the show cages should be treated with disinfectant and the checking in tables should be treated and wiped between each batch of exhibitors' birds.
- 6. To avoid cross contamination, show cages should not be stacked on top of each other or cage front to cage front. Ideally show cages should not be placed on floor at any time.
- 7. A suitable procedure should be adopted that ensures the minimum movement of all exhibits.
- 8. Any sick birds will be removed from the Show area and be placed in a separate disinfected room.
- 9. Sales birds bought at the show, buyers must isolate the purchased bird(s) from any other birds (except those bought at the same event) for at least one week. Any signs of ill health observed in the purchased bird(s) during this period must be reported to a veterinary surgeon and such birds must not be mixed with any other birds until the presence of an avian notifiable disease has been ruled out.

At junction 20A, exit onto M56 toward North Wales/Chester/Runcorn 9.6 miles.


At junction 12, take the A557 exit to Frodsham/Runcorn Airport/Widnes 0.2 miles.
